

Having trouble uploading or accessing your vaccination certificate..... You are not alone. Where can you find help.

There are various ways you can show COVID-19 proof of vaccination to gain entry to businesses and venues in Victoria.

1. COVID-19 digital certificate via the Service Victoria app:

Find out how to get your COVID-19 vaccination certificate, update it if it's incorrect, and show you are vaccinated even if you don't have a Medicare card. This site provides information on how to include your family

2. COVID-19 digital certificate saved to a smartphone wallet:

Use your COVID-19 digital certificate to show proof of your COVID-19 vaccinations when in Australia. You can also add it to your digital wallet. These sites provide instructions on how and where to save your certifications on your electronic devices.
