- An injury or illness that is suitable for management in a primary care setting
- Requires same day review
- Is unable to access GP and/or only option is to present to ED

<b>Respiratory</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bronchitis</li> <li>• Minor illnesses</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Serious breathing difficulties</li> </ul>
<b>Gut</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• IV rehydration – gastritis, hyperemesis</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Crohns</li> <li>• Diverticulitis</li> </ul>
<b>Ear Nose and Throat</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ear Nose Throat conditions</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Complication from surgery (contact surgeon)</li> </ul>
<b>Fainting or Fitting</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• After fitting and recovery to normal, all ages, not related to head injury</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Unconscious collapse/falls with concurrent anticoagulant or antiplatelet use Limp or floppy child, not responding.</li> </ul>
<b>Skin condition/ allergy</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rash</li> <li>• Infected pimple or cyst</li> <li>• Lumps and bumps, cuts or scratches</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Anaphylaxis, suspected meningococcal</li> </ul>
<b>Infants and Pregnancy</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• First trimester bleeding (mild) Paediatrics</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Appendicitis</li> <li>• Pregnancy issues post first trimester</li> <li>• Ectopic pregnancy</li> </ul>
<b>Miscellaneous</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Simple Dental pain</li> <li>• Minor illnesses</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Complication from surgery (contact surgeon)</li> <li>• Severe pain</li> <li>• Unable to mobilise independently or unassisted with existing aid</li> <li>• Drug overdose</li> <li>• Administration of narcotic analgesia prior to arrival</li> <li>• Requirement for ongoing Intravenous narcotic analgesia</li> <li>• Unstable or complex mental health issues</li> <li>• Not managing at home/likely to be admitted Bariatric (&gt; 200kg)</li> </ul>
