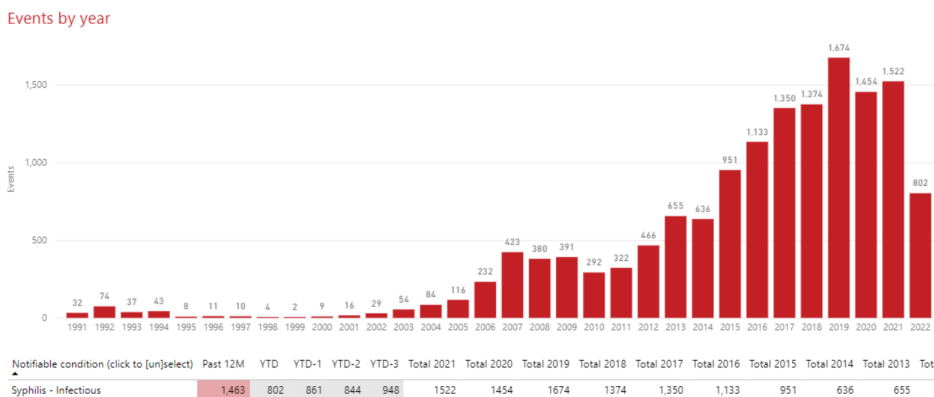


Syphilis: Advanced for Primary Care

Victoria has seen a 476% increase in Syphilis cases since 2010, with a record 1671 cases reported in 2019.

This session provides the skills and resources required for primary health care practitioners to confidently implement guideline-based management of patients diagnosed with Syphilis and to improve patient outcomes. Increased frequency of testing of pregnant women is part of the updated Health Alert on Congenital Syphilis issued March 2021.
