Currently, the alcohol-related death rate across the Gippsland region is the highest in Victoria.

GPs in Gippsland have reported:

- Consulting a drug related
 patient at least once per week
- Contacting specialists for advice on treating drug-related issues multiple times per week, and
- They'd like more education and resources around AOD related issues.

To better support health professionals across the region to, in turn, better support their patients overcome the impacts of AOD, a Gippsland specific learning platform with **evidencebased resources** will be available from 1 July 2022. The range of resources have undergone a comprehensive consultation and review process, created by health professionals for health professions.
