

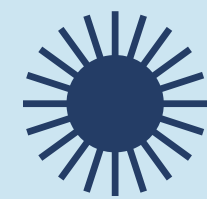


Capacity Tracker

BUILDING HEALTH NETWORK CAPACITY ACROSS GIPPSLAND



The Capacity Tracker was introduced during the COVID-19 pandemic to improve local coordination between General Practices (GPs), Residential Aged Care Facilities (RACFs) and Community Pharmacies (CPs)



The Capacity Tracker has the capability to highlight the infection rates for a selected area in the event of a pandemic like COVID-19 to understand where testing and vaccination is required



The Capacity Tracker has filtered views, allowing the PHN to access critical information quickly for communication to the Commonwealth Department of Health where required



The Capacity Tracker gives Gippsland PHN a detailed overview of aged care facilities and resources to aid in identifying surge capacity in the event of an emergency



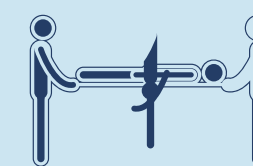
The Capacity Tracker keeps the Gippsland PHN informed and connected to Gippsland's GPs, RACFs and CPs through sharing information and responding effectively



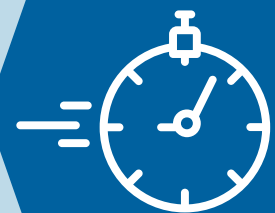
The Capacity Tracker enables Gippsland PHN to support aged care staff and facilities in the event of a crisis



Capacity Tracker allows Gippsland PHN to have a linked-up view of business continuity for RACFs across Gippsland PHN



The Capacity Tracker helps to improve Gippsland's emergency response in aged care procedures



The Capacity Tracker allows for RACFs to quickly and efficiently raise risks or issues



The Capacity Tracker is updated in real time, allowing for instant sharing of information about stock levels for PPE, bed availability, COVID-19 infection and vaccination rates, and staffing levels



The Capacity Tracker assists the PHN to coordinate services between RACF, GPs and CPs.



The Capacity Tracker enables reporting on a relevant crisis, allowing the PHN to collate different snapshots of data from residential aged care facilities and GP practices.
