The Gippsland PHN RAP seeks to acknowledge the diversity and cultures of Aboriginal people across Gippsland and identify how to best support local communities to live long and healthy lives. The RAP artwork will be a visual representation of Gippsland PHN's vision and journey towards reconciliation.

The remuneration for this work is **\$3000 (ex GST)**
