Funding for Gippsland mental health services

Gippsland Primary Health Network has funded 11 organisations to deliver Primary Mental Health Care and Psychosocial Support services across Gippsland.

The new contracts are the first to be rolled out as part of Gippsland PHN's new outcomes-focused commissioning approach.

Gippsland PHN's aim is for the process to be informed by best practice and through consultation with people who have lived experience. Importantly, the change was informed by the Royal Commission into Victoria's Mental Health System.

Extensive consultation was also undertaken with service providers, clinicians and community.

Gippsland PHN also funds the Head to Health service, suicide prevention services, the mental health in aged care program and Child and Youth services which aim to help young people 12-25 years old to access mental health support through headspace centres across Gippsland.



Gippsland PHN Chief Executive Officer, Amanda Proposch, said programs would be delivered in a way that meets their needs to improve the overall health and wellbeing of people living in Gippsland.

"We recognise the seriousness of mental health in our community and we are committed to ensuring people can access the most appropriate services for their mental health needs at any given time— including the ability to step up and step down to different levels of care as they move along their recovery journey," Ms Proposch said.
