We can all help to save lives with QPR

Question, Persuade, Refer (QPR) is a leading online course that aims to save lives by providing innovative, practical and proven suicide prevention training.

Quality education empowers all people, regardless of their background, to make a positive difference in the life of someone they know.

Just like CPR, QPR is an emergency response to someone in crisis and can save lives. QPR is the most widely taught suicide prevention training in the world.

Gippsland PHN is offering this online training for **free** to help people identify the warning signs of someone at risk, give them the confidence to speak to someone about their thoughts and provide them with the tools to connect those in need with professional care.

QPR (Question, Persuade and Refer) and is a 90 minute, self-paced online course that anyone can do from home. You can progress through the course at your own pace by logging in and continuing it whenever suits.

All people living, working or studying in Gippsland are eligible for the free registration. This course is for people who have not completed any prior training in suicide prevention or Mental Health First Aid.
