Who:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fellows of a medical college – including newly admitted – you are eligible to complete the VAD training and encouraged to attend. All GPs and specialists are welcome – not only the host health service GPs - This activity is approved for 9.5 RACGP CPD hours (including pre-session completion of modules 1 & 2) – 7.5 hours Education Activities and 2 hours Reviewing Performance
What to do next:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Register to attend by clicking on one of the event links above (the training is one day only) <p>Pre-requisites:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Also register for the training https://vicvadlearninghub.com/ when you register for the training day (do this at least a day before you plan to start the training as per next step) Complete Modules 1, 2 & 3 (approx. 1.5-2 hours) in your own time before the scheduled day.
